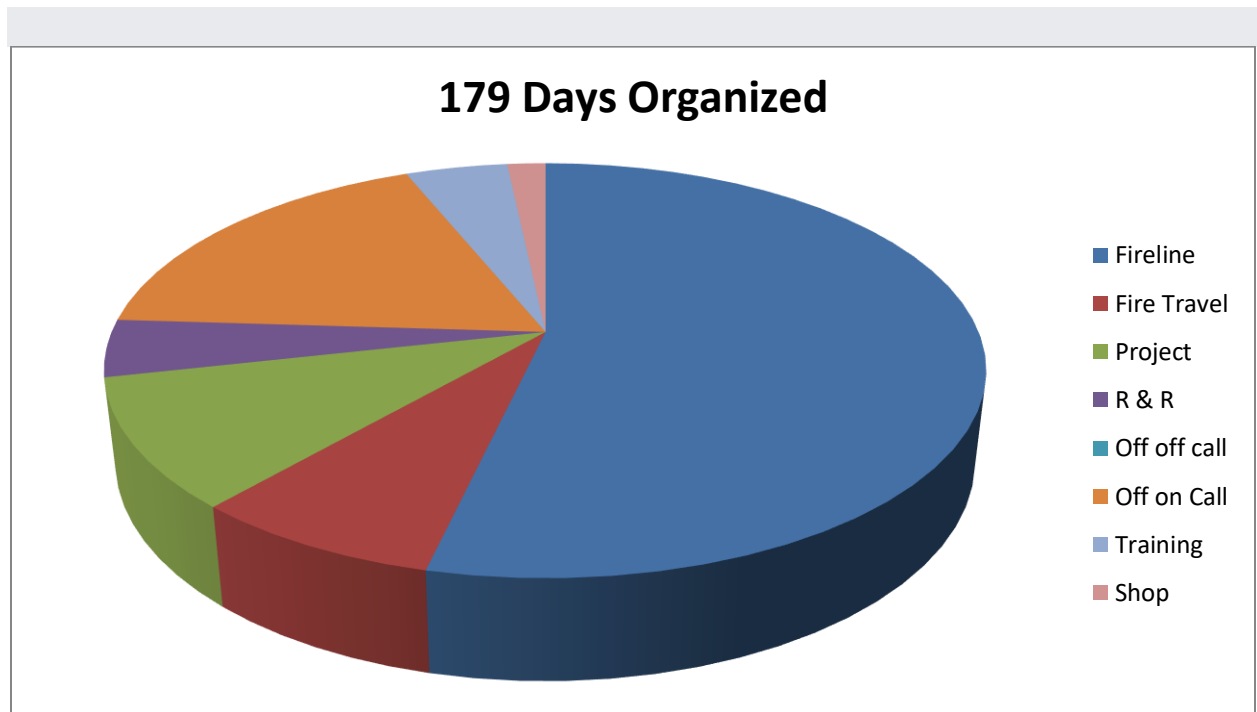
Season Summary

On April 22nd 2019, the Alta Hotshots welcomed back 16 crew members from previous seasons and added 7 new hires for the 2019 fire season; the crew completed 80 hours of critical training and successfully passed a base review before going nationally available on May 2nd.

The 2019 fire season started slow with our first fire dispatch coming on June 11th – the slow start allowed the crew to complete 5 weeks of critical fuels reduction work within the State of Utah. The fuels reduction work was beneficial not only for the areas we worked in but also for the crew as we were able to start building crew cohesion in a work environment.

The season was filled with diverse assignments ranging from large scale firing operations to mopping-up grass fires in the desert. Multiple details and training assignments were ongoing throughout the season and these assignments ranged from a season long Squad Leader detail to incident specific DIVS, TFLD, CRWB, ENGB, HEQB, FFT1, ICT4, and ICT5 training assignments.

Overall, it was a challenging yet successful season - the crew was assembled for 179 days and in that time was assigned to 19 fires in 6 states; 16 task books were completed and countless training opportunities seized throughout the season.

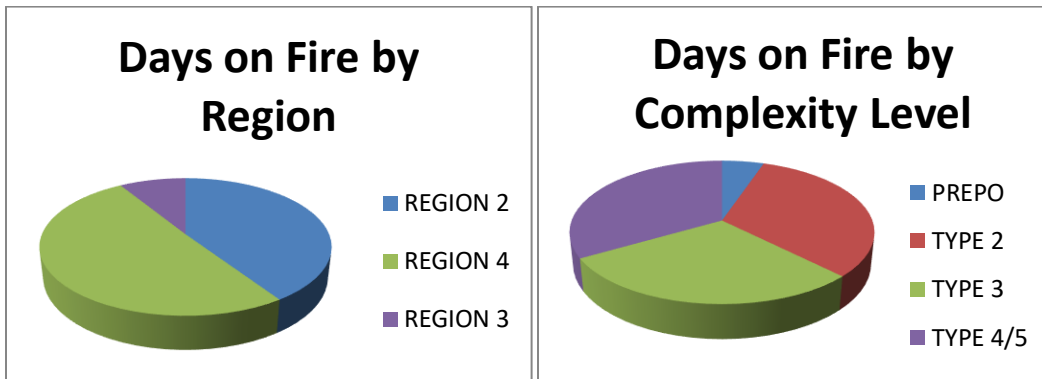
