Throughout the 2024 fire season, we were sent to Arizona, California, Idaho, and New Mexico to aid in fire suppression. Prospective crewmembers must be prepared for rigorous physical training. This includes running, and hiking with heavy loads. Being physically prepared prior to the job offer will set you up for success if you're extended an offer on Twin Peaks.
